

Victoria Park Campground

Please check in at office for site number before proceeding to your site.
Payment due upon registration

Check in time: 3:00 PM
Check out time: 1:00 PM

Quiet Time

Please observe the campground quiet time between 11:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m. Use of loud equipment during this time is prohibited.

Pets:

All pets must be leashed, tied up, or caged and under physical control at all times. Pet owners are responsible for cleaning up after their pets.

Campsite availability

Non-reserved campsites are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Directly following registration, the camping unit specified on the permit must be located on the campsite (camping unit means any tent, tent-trailer, camper-truck, camping trailer, fifth wheel or motor home.) Tents must be set up.

Temporary removal of camping unit

Unless prior arrangements have been made with the Park Attendant, a campsite will be considered vacant if the camping unit is removed from the site. If you have made arrangements and vacated your spot the Park may rent out the spot if necessary. Under no circumstances is a camper allowed to "sub let" their site. Permit holders operating camper-trucks and motor homes may temporarily vacate the campsite if the licence number of the unit is recorded on the permit, and the campground office is advised of the temporary departure.

Children at play

Children regularly play in our campgrounds. Please use caution when driving your vehicle or moving your camping unit.

Maximum speed of 10 km/hr

The speed limit in campgrounds is 10 km/hr.

Campfires

Campfires are prohibited except in designated firepots and must be extinguished when the site is unoccupied.

Campsites

Keep the campsite in a clean and sanitary condition at all times. Dispose of waste water only in dump stations or sewer drains provided. Disposal of waste water on the campsites or surrounding areas is not permitted. Dispose of garbage in refuse containers to avoid problem wildlife and leave the site free of litter, and clean for the next camper.

Payment

All reservations require payment or credit card at the time of reservation. By creating a reservation, the customer agrees to abide by all applicable rules and regulations that are conditions of a camping reservation. The customer also agrees to be bound by the cancellation policies in effect.

Cancellation Policies

You can cancel your reservation and collect a full refund on your camping fees if you cancel 4 or more days before your arrival date. If your cancellation occurs 3 days or less before the arrival date, your fees will be refunded except for the first night's camping fee. Remember, if you don't cancel your reservation or do not show up, all fees are forfeited. Requests for refunds for leaving your stay early only for medical reasons and must be requested in writing to the Victoria Park Board.

Changes

Changes to reservations regarding dates and location may be allowed depending on availability.

Late Arrivals

We understand that there may be times when your arrival is delayed so we will hold your site until 11:00 a.m. the next day before cancellation. If you can not arrive by 11:00 a.m., you must call the park to see if a later in-the-day check in can be accommodated. Sites will not be held as a late arrival for longer than one night and will be cancelled as a "no show" with all fees forfeited. Fees will apply for each night your reservation is held.

Allowable Camping Units

Each campsite is designed for one camping unit. A camping unit would be defined as a tent, tent-trailer, travel trailer, truck-camper, motor home or fifth wheel. If space allows, an additional tent and dining tent may also be used.
